Semester 1

Digital Leadership

Innovative decision-making in an evolving digital workplace, leverage data and technology to lead and sustain change.

Project Management Systems

Project life-cycle, organizational structures, project charters, project scope statements, work breakdown structures; planning and control methods introduced such as PERT/CPM, Gantt charts, earned value systems and project management information system software

Semester 2

Program Management

Plan, strategize, manage program benefits, engage with stakeholders and create appropriate governance controls.

Project Cost and Schedule Control

Schedule estimation, budgeting; resource allocation and leveling; schedule analysis techniques; use of earned value management systems and project change control; project metrics.

Semester 3

Communication for a Diverse Workplace

Risk management planning, risk identification, risk analysis, planning and implementation of risk responses and risk monitoring.

Managing IT Projects

Fundamental project management concepts, with a focus on agile methodologies. Students complete various project management documents related to managing IT projects.
