

New Jersey Reverse Transfer

Effective July 13, 2020

DeVry University has developed this Reverse Transfer Guide to assist students in understanding the reverse transfer process.

Process

Students must:

1. Contact your student support advisor to discuss eligibility requirements
2. If eligible, request release of their DeVry transcripts to their community college. Please contact your SSA prior to requesting your DeVry transcript.

Eligibility Requirements

The following are the general eligibility requirements for participation in reverse transfer. Your community college may have additional requirements.

- Students must have met the residency requirement and designated minimum grade point average at the Community College prior to enrollment at DeVry University.
- Students must have applied and been admitted to DeVry University.
- Following enrollment at DeVry University, students must have earned a cumulative total of 66 semester hours between the Community College and DeVry University.
- Students must be current with financial obligations to both DeVry University and the Community College.
- Students must have met all of the graduation requirements of the Community College.
